3. What role would you have on the hero team?

A rescuer, protector, detective, encourager or planner? Your role can reflect work, life outside work, or something you would love to be.

4. What are your powers or special talents?

What can you do, and how does it help? Fly, mend things, talk to plants, calm a crowd...

5. What are you like, in and out of hero mode?

A few traits, habits or quirks: quietly brave, curious, quick with a joke, always carrying snacks...

Your character doesn't have to look like you to feel like you. Choose any colors, shapes and details.

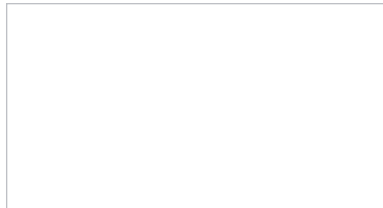
