1. Your real name, exactly as it should appear

A first name is enough. We will use this name on your character artwork.

2. What kind of magical character would you be?

A spell-casting owl, potion-making fox, cloud creature or enchanted object.

3. What role would you have in the magical community?

A teacher, healer, spell inventor, librarian or guardian? Your role can reflect work, life outside work, or something you would love to be.

4. What is your magical specialty?

Plant magic, weather, illusions, enchanted baking... What spell or talent would you be known for?

5. What are you like when the magic starts?

Methodical, mischievous, gentle, dramatic? Add a habit or quirk, such as singing while casting spells.

Your character doesn't have to look like you to feel like you. Choose any colors, shapes and details.

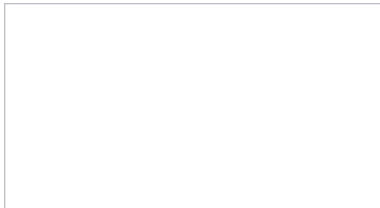
